- Spreadsheet on the Afton vital records held by the Town Clerk. This sheet will eventually enable her ease of access to these old record books. Have completed through 2020 (births and deaths) and 1987 (marriages) thus far.
- East Side Cemetery information is being assembled for upcoming book.
- Assisting in the straightening up of the Town Court Records Room.
- Received 100 copies of my book, "Sand Hill Cemetery" in March and have sold 97; donated a copy to Unadilla Public Library and The Fenimore Research Center, Cooperstown; 1 remaining copy.



- Began cleaning gravestone in Chestnut Hill Cemetery in Unadilla. It is abandoned and will be my next book due by Christmas. We have located two stones so far that were down and buried. Have reset them. (26 hours)
- o Deep cleaning and reorganizing displays at the Museum.
- Inventoried all the ACS materials that Dan DeVona had collected. The list was submitted to the Superintendent, Tim McNamara and then the Board of Education. They approved moving the items to the Museum. Items were picked up and moved to Museum (11 archival boxes, 18 scrapbooks, slides, newspapers)
- Mug sales have begun. Promotion of all 3 mugs for \$25 was well received and have sold out of our first mug.
