

Code Enforcement Report

Village Board Meeting August 14, 2023

Received a phone call from an interested buyer about building codes for a home on Main Street. Referred to Chenango County.

Had the lounge chair removed from the side of the building on Spring Street.

Spring Street homeowner complained about water running across their drive from neighbors yard. Spoke with landlord to address the problem. Continuing to follow up.

Homeowner called on Spring Street about installing a coal burning furnace. Referred to Chenango County.

Homeowners on Main Street called and complained about downed trees and overgrown weeds from the yellow houses.

Complaint from homeowner about branches being burned on East Main Street. Fire was under control and contained. (trimmings from tree)

A contractor called about installing outside stairs. Referred to Chenango County.

Homeowner on Caswell Street called about vacant property not mowed. Spoke with the Management Company to get the problem resolved. (150 Caswell)

Spoke with Afton first assistant Fire Chief about a home on Caswell Street with a misfired furnace. Chenango County follow up.

Called and talked with landlords and homeowners about trash, junk and household items in yards on Main, Sand, Maple, and Caswell Streets. Following up with Chenango County.

Delivered a Septic Permit for a home on Caswell Street.

Continuing to send letters and make calls to homeowners to maintain lawns.

Homeowner called about a small driveway installation on Evergreen Street. Spoke with Bailey for his input.

Continuing to monitor Unlicensed/Unregistered vehicles in Village.

Attended a Planning Board Meeting.
