

Village of Afton Lawn debris and reference sheet

This is a notice of DPW/Village operations. The Board of Trustees and DPW employees are asking for resident's cooperation.

Thank you in advance!

Spring

Pickup begins in April - weather permitting. Pick up will be through May as needed.

Hedge trimmings, grass clippings, weeds, dead flowers (not in pots) etc. bagged in clear or paper bags no more than 40 lbs. Sticks/branches should be stacked together, ends facing the same direction, in bundles no more than 3" in diameter and 4' in length.

No garbage or scrap lumber to be included in yard waste

Large whole trees and stumps are to be removed at the homeowner's expense.

Summer

June, July and August debris pickup of yard debris will be Mondays. Please place bags/bundles at the curb the weekend prior to Monday pick up.

Grass should not grow in excess of 5 inches and CAN NOT BE MOWED INTO THE STREET.

Fall

Pickup of leaves starting in October through mid-November or one (1) week after the leaves have fallen. Pick up will be Mondays, however more days may be added, as needed.

Leaves should be raked to the curb, NOT INTO THE STREET. If bagging use clear or paper bags no more than 40lbs.

Leaf vacuum is for leaves only - NO sticks, mulch, stones etc.

Winter

Newly fallen snow/ice must be removed from sidewalks within twenty-four (24) hours.

Parking of vehicles is prohibited on all village streets between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. beginning November 1 and ending April 1 of the following year.

Village will pick up Christmas trees until the end of January. Please leave at curb.

Year round

A scrap metal dumpster is available for village residents to discard metal at the DPW garage.

PLEASE NOTE FOR METAL ONLY

Large metal objects (washers, dryers, stoves etc.) can be dropped off at the dumpster for DPW to load at a later time.

Dogs and cats are not allowed off of owner's property unless leashed. Dogs must be licensed when 6 months old and dogs and cats must be vaccinated for rabies. CLEANING UP AFTER YOU DOG OR CAT WHEN WALKING THEM ON VILLAGE STREETS AND SIDEWALKS IS MANDATORY YEAR-ROUND.

Garbage should not be accumulated for more than 7 days and should not be left at the curbside for pickup for more than 24 hrs.
